The innovations included a single-seater ultra-light helicopter built with scrap materials that weighed 280 kg and said to be both agriculture and eco-friendly; 'Magico Rullstol,' a wheelchair for the physically challenged that has an integrated voice command module and the user operating it solely based on his voice; and a potato planting equipment which allows sowing, plugging and fertilizing all at the same time while utilising no electricity at all.
